

MASONIC RITES

Masonic Rites can only be accorded if previously requested by the deceased member AND/OR by the family. The rites may be done inside the funeral home chapel (which is the best for all because weather is not a factor and the ceremony can be heard by all) after the religious part of the service or at the graveside, in either case it normally falls into the later part of the service and also normally before any military honors if accorded at the grave.

Sometimes the request for Masonic Rites is in the deceased brother's Will or he has made his request to the family or it may have been pre-planned with the funeral director, but if it has not been previously discussed and when the funeral arrangements are being made during which time there is much grief and sorrow, the thought of the Masonic Rites may not be even considered or be overlooked. There are other times when Masonic Rites are not accorded because of religious beliefs or personal family feelings, every situation is different.

MASONIC RITES (CONTINUED)

If you desire Masonic Rites please insure that the request is in writing somewhere (either in a Will or testament) or that your family knows of your requests and agrees to follow through with it by either contacting the Lodge Secretary and/or notifying the funeral director when making the final arrangements. Ask your Lodge Secretary for a Masonic Rites Request Form.


